# Marianjoy Rehabilitation Hospital Enabling Garden

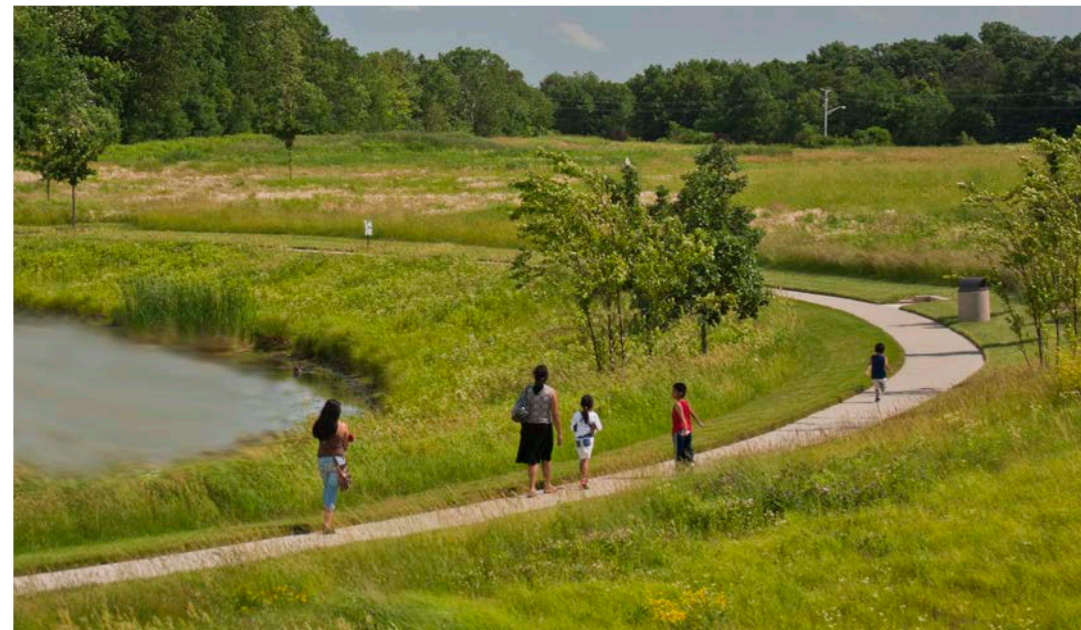
Wheaton, Illinois

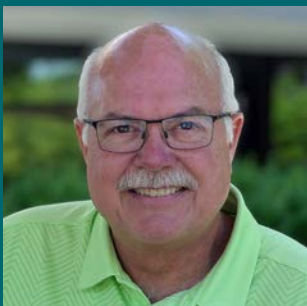
