PROJECT SPOTLIGHT Forest Park Splash Pad Forest Park, Illinois

The new splash pad includes three separate zones for different age groups and types of play including a gentle tot-area with a game board inspired ground plane, a teen area with water guns and color-coded zones, and a candy castle play tower with slides, a gumball dump bucket, and a "moat" filled with gummy-creatures. Each of the three splash pads operate independently and water is treated and recirculated on-site.













PROJECT SPOTLIGHT Colts Canal Playspace Indianapolis, Indiana

The Indianapolis Parks Foundation engaged Hitchcock Design Group to create an innovative, engaging and versatile playspace in downtown Indianapolis. As the playspace is located in the visual foreground of the Indianapolis Skyline and along the canal walk, views of the space are as important as the user's experience of the space.













The Schaumburg Park District retained HDG to lead a team to develop a nature-based play space within the nature center that would immerse children in an ecosystem that included native grasses and forbs, woodland trees, a stream, and a pond. The goal of the project is to lead children through an exploration of three ecosystems including a prairie, a wetland, and a savanna.









PROJECT SPOTLIGHT Bellaboo's Imagination Garden Lake Station, Indiana

A natural extension of the wildly successful Bellaboo's Play & Discovery Center, the Imagination Garden brings the excitement of learning through play outside, transforming unused area into a robust children's garden and learning campus for families of all ages and abilities. The unique travel destination brings opportunities to play, learn, and splash.











PROJECT SPOTLIGHT Marquette Park Gary, Indiana

After completing the Lakefront East Master Plan to guide the revitalization of historic Marquette Park, HDG served as program manager and lead consultant on the capital improvements for the park. The improvements included the restoration of the three historic structures within the park: the Father Marquette Monument, the Recreation Pavilion, and the Gary Bathing Beach Aquatorium.









PROJECT SPOTLIGHT Paducah Sports Park Paducah, Kentucky

The Paducah Sports Park will be developed on the former site of the Bluegrass Downs horse track and the historic Stuart Nelson Park in Paducah, Kentucky. The project will include 10 multipurpose artificial turf fields, 3 playgrounds, 2 basketball courts, and 16 pickleball courts, disc golf, trails, shelters, and landscape enhancements. A plaza and gathering area is planned for the center of the new facility to celebrate the history of the park.







PROJECT SPOTLIGHT Southeast Metro All-Abilities Playground Austin, Texas

Southeast Metro Park is an inclusive all-abilities playground built with universal components to create an area of play that supports the cognitive, physical, sensory, visual, and auditory needs of all children. The main play feature for the park is a 30-foot-long Mosasour, a nod to the historic discovery of the fossilized remains of a Mosasour in Onion Creek, which borders the park.
